Before you proceed with an appeal please read the following notes these have been given out verbally and in written format and your Club / Team has failed to comply with an order / instruction given by a member of the Management Committee Assuming you have passed onto your managers the verbal instructions given out at WFL meetings, and referred them to the WFL website where all minutes are posted under the secure log in for them to obtain and read, I fail to see what there problem is. If you have not passed this information onto them, maybe they should hold you accountable for the fine. If after reading this you wish to proceed with an appeal please send it in accordingly to be received with in 7 days of being issued.

On all fixtures issued by Dan Lauszkin U18 Fixture Secretary he has noted that U18 can only use three from five named substitutes, there is no roll on roll off allowed. Simple enough to understand if you can only use three from five named there should only be a maximum of 14 players listed.

At meetings 10<sup>th</sup> October / 21<sup>st</sup> November & 9<sup>th</sup> January the same information has been given out verbally, minutes of the meeting with in 48 hours have been posted on the WFL website, clear for everyone to read.

Football Mitoo home page black box starting with **UNDER 18'S WITH EFFECT FROM THE 8TH JANUARY ANY U18 TEAM THAT LISTS MORE THAN 14 PLAYERS O ... continue** and if you click on the word continue the rest of the notice reads ON THEIR RESULT CARD WILL BE FINED FOR PLAYING AN OTHERWISE IN-ELIGIBLE PLAYER FOR WHICH THE FINE IS £50.00. CLUB SECRETARIES AT LEAGUE MEETINGS HAVE VERBALLY BEEN TOLD TO INFORM ALL U18 MANAGERS THAT U18 CAN ONLY USE 3 FROM 5 NAMED SUBSTITUTES AND THEIR IS NO ROLL ON ROLL OFF. SO THE MAXIMUM PLAYERS LISTED ON THEIR RESULT CARD SHOULD NOT EXCEED 14 PLAYERS. ALSO ONLY SUBSTITUTES THAT TOOK PART IN THE GAME NEED TO BE NAMED. IF THE SUBSTITUTE DID NOT PLAY DO NOT PUT HIS NAME DOWN. THIS MESSAGE HAS ALSO BEEN POSTED ON THE LEAGUE WEBSITE AND THE U18 FIXTURE SECRETARY DAN LAUSZKIN HAS ALSO INCLUDED ON THE COVERING LETTER WITH HIS FIXTURES.

And lastly the following email was sent via club secretaries on 11<sup>th</sup> December @ 19.38 asking for it to be passed onto your U18 managers and again I assume you did this. Dear Club Sec Please pass this onto your Under 18 managers, with effect from the 8<sup>th</sup> January any U18 team that list more than 14 players on their result card will be fined for playing an otherwise ineligible player for which the fine is £50.00 You have verbally been told at all league meetings that U18 can only use 3 from 5 named substitutes and there is no roll on roll off. So the maximum players listed on their result card should not exceed 14 This message has also been posted on the league website, on football Mitoo and Dan Lauszkin U18 fixture secretary has also included it on the covering letter on his fixtures. **It also clearly states in the WFL rulebook and on your result card to only include substitutes who took part in the game.**
